If you have in your care a child whom you intend to adopt, and wish to register or re-register the child with a doctor under the National Health Service, you fill in the form below and take it to the doctor of your choice. When the doctor accepts the child as a patient, arrangements will be made for you to receive a medical card in the child's new name (if there is a change of name) and with a new National Health Service number, which cannot be linked in any way with the child's previous records.

You will notice that there is no reference to adoption in the form itself; please detach it from these notes and use it on its own.

You may have registered the child already with your doctor, using a form provided by the doctor or the Executive Council. If so, you should re-register the child, using the form below if you want to ensure that the special arrangements are made for keeping the adoption confidential.

You may also have received from the Court to which you have applied for an adoption order a form like the one below. If so, and if you have used it, there is no need to fill in the form below. If the Court gives you a form after you have used this one, do not complete it.

If you have the old medical card, you should destroy it when you receive the new one.
